**Eligibility**

All OCBA USBC BA Youth bowlers are eligible to enter this tournament. Sanctioned youth bowlers that live in Ozaukee County will also be allowed to participate.

**Divisions**

All bowlers will compete in the same division. Approximately 1 in 4 will receive scholarship money.

**Entering Average**

All bowlers will enter using their highest current USBC Youth league average, minimum of 9 games as of 1/1/2024. If no current season average use previous season USBC Youth league average, minimum nine games. Bowlers without a nine game minimum USBC Youth average may enter scratch.

**Handicap**

Handicap will be 90 percent of the difference between the bowler's average and a scratch score of 200. All bowlers averaging over 200 will get 0 handicap.

**Tournament format**

Both Singles and Doubles will be a 3 game, total pinfall (with handicap) format. Doubles will be bowled first. Bowlers will stay on their assigned lanes for all 6 games. If you don't have a doubles partner, we will pair you up with someone else who doesn't have a partner. We would like all bowlers to bowl both singles and doubles. Should you choose to only bowl singles, your event will start whenever the doubles event ends, and the bowler will not receive any practice.

**Entry fee**

Entry fee will be \$15 (\$8 lineage fee and \$7 Scholarship fee) per event, or \$30 total. Mail entries and fees to:
